An Ordinance to amend Chapter 20 of Article VI of the St. Martin Parish Code of Ordinances by the repeal, amendment, revision, and/or re-enactment of 20-174 of the said Chapter 20 of Article VI, all relative to the operation of video draw poker devices within St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.
