

**MINUTES OF THE ST. MARTIN PARISH  
CITIZEN REAPPORTIONMENT COMMITTEE MEETING FEBRUARY 11, 2022**

The St. Martin Parish Citizen Reapportionment Committee Meeting met at 5:01 P.M., Friday, February 11, 2022, Carroll J. Fuselier Meeting Room, St. Martin Parish Annex Building, 301 West Port Street, St. Martinville, Louisiana.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kirk Sieber.
