The meeting was called to order by Chairman Chris Tauzin.

The Invocation was read by Brooke Gillespie, and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tangie Narcisse.

Parish President Chester Cedars declared this ordinance merges some of the precincts established at the June 7 Council meeting and assigns polling locations to those 42 precincts. St. Martin Parish resident Andrew Babineaux expressed concerns about people in District 9 having to travel to the Cecilia Civic Center to vote. St. Martin Parish Clerk of Court Becky Patin and Elections Department Deputy Clerk Tricia Hammon addressed Mr. Babineaux's concerns.

Upon requesting and hearing no further comments from the audience regarding the proposed ordinance being considered for final adoption, the Chairman requested a motion to close the Public Hearing.

A motion was made by Brook Champagne and seconded by Byron Fuselier that the Public Hearing be closed.

MERGER OF CERTAIN QUALIFYING VOTING PRECINCTS FOR ST. MARTIN PARISH FROM PRECINCTS CREATED IN PLAN A AND THE DESCRIPTION THEREOF, PRECINCT RENUMBERING, AND ASSIGNMENT OF POLLING LOCATIONS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CURRENT PARISH PRECINCT ORDINANCE NO. 02-03-0206-OR, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NOS. 19-12-1281-OR AND 22-06-1360-OR, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MERGING OF QUALIFYING VOTING PRECINCTS FOR THE PARISH OF ST. MARTIN IN ACCORDANCE WITH RS: 18.532.1, PRECINCT RENUMBERING, AND ASSIGNMENT OF POLLING LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, the Census 2020 count has been completed and the PL 94-171 reapportionment data was delivered to the State of Louisiana on the 12th of August, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana has completed their redistricting in February, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the St. Martin Parish School Board has adopted their redistricting Plan A as of June 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the St. Martin Parish Council has adopted their redistricting Plan A and the accompanying precinct ordinance as of June 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 18:532.1 D.(1)(b), provides that the parish governing authority may merge precincts upon the parish governing authority's certifying in writing that the parish governing authority and the school board have completed redistricting, and that such permission has been granted by the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, the St. Martin Parish Council wishes to renumber the precincts in sequential numerical order and assign the polling locations for each; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, the St. Martin Parish Council hereby merges the qualifying precincts and describes the new precinct boundaries as described in the attached Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the post-merger precincts are hereby re-numbered in sequential numerical order and the polling locations assigned as described in Exhibit B.

Precinct 16A.
