An Ordinance to authorize the St. Martin Parish Government to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with Myran Chautin and Karen Richard Chautin, husband and wife, relative to the use as a recreational facility two parcels of land totaling .160 acres in the Town of Arnaudville, Louisiana.
