Consider the adoption of an Ordinance to allow for the reduction of the drainage servitude on Lateral (L-34G) of the drainage system of St. Martin Parish Government from the current statutory limit of one hundred (100) feet to a limit of twenty-five (25) feet only on property where the Parish maintained canal traverses from the northern to the northeastern boundary of Grand Point Estates Subdivision, located off La Hwy 347, Grand Loop (District 5), in Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 6 East, St. Martin Parish, as described on the attached plat of survey dated October 28, 2006, and prepared by Mohammad S. Borazjani, Registered Professional Land Surveyor.

Consider the adoption of an Ordinance to allow for the reduction of the drainage servitude on Main (M-34) of the drainage system of St. Martin Parish Government from the current statutory limit of one hundred (100) feet to a limit of fifty (50) feet only on property where the Parish maintained canal traverses from the western to the southwestern boundary of Grand Point Estates Subdivision, located off La Hwy 347, Grand Loop (District 5), in Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 6 East, St. Martin Parish, as described on the attached plat of survey dated October 28, 2006, and prepared by Mohammad S. Borazjani, Registered Professional Land Surveyor.
